NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF SEADOGS, SANCTA BERMUDA SCHOLARSHIPS REGULATIONS FOR 2012

BACKGROUND

This scholarship has been made available by the **National Association of Seadogs, Enugu Chapter**, to support qualified students from the Enugu State and non-indigenes of Enugu State who have been residents of Enugu State for up to 10 years, to progress their undergraduate studies in any higher institution in Nigeria.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These Scholarships will be known as the National Association of Seadogs, Sancta Bermuda Scholarships.
- 2. Applications will be open to students from Sancta Bermuda enrolled in any University who completed a first year of study for an undergraduate degree not later than 2011 and who in 2012 will be enrolling as full-time students in further courses, principally at second or higher levels, towards any undergraduate degree.
- 3. Applicants must be from Enugu State or have been residents for not less than ten (10) years, and have demonstrable evidence.
- 4. Two Scholarships will usually be awarded annually. The National Association of Seadogs (NAS), Sancta Bermuda Scholarship Selection Panel will usually offer one award on the basis of the applicant's academic merit and the second award on the basis of the applicant's financial position, i.e. financial hardship (although this can be varied at the Selection Panel's discretion in exceptional cases, provided the candidate has a record of excellent academic standing). In addition, importance will be placed on applicant's involvement in building a just society and other personal circumstances that illustrate their positive participation in their community at large. Applicants need to clearly establish their credentials in light of these criteria as the National Association of Seadogs, is a community service organization committed in fighting constraints militating against the attainment of a just society and in providing these scholarships, it seeks to encourage and reward positive community service and involvement.
- 5. The Selection Committee will comprise members of The National Association of Seadogs (NAS), Sancta Bermuda.
- 6. The remuneration of each scholarship will be N20,000.00 credited towards tuition fees at any higher institution in Nigeria in the year of tenure of the Scholarship.
- 7. No cash payment be made in respect of this Scholarship.
- 8. If having been awarded a Scholarship, a scholar withdraws from the university and is no longer enrolled as a **full-time student**, the scholar may be required to refund all or part of the Scholarship.
- 9. The National Association of Seadogs (NAS), Sancta Bermuda Scholarship Panel will contact applicants after the closing date for applications. The Selection Committee may contact ONLY selected applicants.
- 10. Applications should be made on the form available from the National Association of Seadogs (NAS) website www.nas-int.org
- 11. The due date for applications is the 30th March 2012.
